RIDES & SLIDES













O'Hana Highway Tube Slide - is our newest slide! Ride alone or grab a double tube and head upstairs with your friend or family member.

FlowRider- enjoy the thrill of surfing without the intense ocean environment! This challenging and exciting attraction is sure to bring the surfer out of everyone!

Pineapple Plunge - hold on to your lunch because this 40 feet high speed plunge slide drops you at a 45-degree angle 135 feet long to the ground below!

Pelican Plunge - will leave you disoriented! This 40 feet high enclosed slide is our most "extreme" slide, twisting and turning 265 feet, this slide includes "translucent" bands along the route that will provide an extra thrill!

Tangerine Twist Slide - starts at 35 feet off the ground which you will flow through almost 200 feet of twisting tract dropping into a nice cool plunge pool below!

Blue Macaw Slide - is an open top slide that gently slides you along a 200 feet path from 30 feet in the air to a plunge pool below.

Crocodile Creek Lazy River - is great for those who want to take it slow and easy! You can relax and spend endless hours floating around. Along the way watch out for the waterfall and other surprises!

Caribbean Splash Wave Pool - enjoy waves without all the sand! Our giant wave pool has over 85,000 gallons of water for all day fun!

Tiny Turtle Island Kiddie Pool - short in depth perfect for our tiny guests where they can climb, splash and play to their heart's content!

Toucan's Cove Activity Pool - that is connected to the Lazy River is a body of water that is almost 250,000 gallons of aquatic fun with a basketball goal and other activity structures.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Are lifejackets required?

Lifejackets are not required, but are available on a first come first serve basis. Lifejackets are located beside the lazy river.

How can I tell my schools students from other schools?

Each school that visits on the same day will have different color wristbands. Example: X School with have Blue Wristbands and Y School with have Red Wristbands.

Will parents be allowed?

That is up to your school. If you allow parents, their tickets will need to be prepurchased through your school. Parrot Island has no way to know your parents from the general public. If you would like to sell ticket to you parents the day of your event. Parrot Island ticket windows will be available for use.

Can the students exit without me knowing?

Due to fire regulations we cannot shut and lock the front gate. We will however have a chaperone table set up at the front gate on the day of your visit. We recommend having one school representative stations there, but it is not required.





Can we bring our own lunch?

Yes. Sack lunches can be brought in for students.

Are your food stands open?

Yes. The Island Breeze Snack Shack and Mini Melts Ice Cream will be open.

Can my school use a cabana for the day?

Yes. Only on School Dayz cabanas are free to use. Most schools use them as a meeting place, and a place for teachers, and school staff to stay cool and still be in the park with their students.

How do we get our tickets?

The group sales department will get you an allocated amount of wristbands before your event. On the day of your visit just bring back what you have leftover. You will only be charged for what you did not bring back.
